We believe ALL children deserve the chance of a loving, permanent home through adoption wherever possible.


There is an estimated 2,500 children waiting for an adoptive home in the UK.

Sadly, children aged 4 years and above, sibling groups, those with additional learning, physical or emotional needs and children from black and minority ethnic families are amongst the children who wait longest to be adopted. **We want to help change that**.

Adoption Matters has a successful track record in placing children from a range of backgrounds and the expert ongoing support and training we offer means that we have one of the lowest disruption rates in the UK.

Children are at the heart of our work and we are proud of the award winning service we offer to our adoptive families.

Our history

The Anglican Church has always taken its commitment to social responsibility very seriously – the Board for Social Responsibility dealt with adoption, homelessness, unemployment, social justice and more. Eventually, around the time the Adoption of Children Act 1949 was passed, the Chester Diocesan Adoption Society/Blackburn Diocesan Adoption Agency were formed in 1955 and 1947 respectively. The two agencies merged in 2007 eventually becoming Adoption Matters.

We are proud of our Christian roots and our work within the community. We operate an open and non discriminative ethos in all aspects of our work and we welcome applicants of from all walks of life, backgrounds, ages, sexuality, faiths and people who have no religious beliefs.

There is no 'perfect' adopter, we need adopters from a range of backgrounds and cultures.

In January 2015, an Adoption Matters led consortium of Voluntary Adoption Agencies, together with the Christian charity Home for Good, were awarded funding by the Department of Education to develop a model to encourage more people from the Christian community become adoptive parents, for children who tend to wait the longest for adoption.

This hurts because we are! The children we adopt will be absolutely ours, our very own.


But it also hurts because the assumption behind the question is that adoption is somehow less than biologically conceiving and giving birth to a child.
