The Spring Harvest team are pleased to announce that bookings for their annual Easter break in 2021 are now being taken. A quick turn-around following lockdown earlier this year meant that Spring Harvest went from a three venue event to a completely free 'online only' event entitled Spring Harvest Home. However, the team are now taking bookings for three breaks to be held at the Butlin's Minehead and Skegness resorts in April 2021.

Phil Loose, CEO of the Essential Christian charity says,

"This year we have been blown away by the encouragement and generosity of all those who have tuned in, and are grateful to those who donated and supported us in what has been one of the most challenging years in our existence. The investment from those committed individuals has meant we can continue as a ministry and plan for the coming year. While the coronavirus pandemic has clearly had a huge impact, we are hoping, praying and planning to be back over Easter 2021."

Current COVID restrictions mean that places will be limited for 2021 but assurances have been provided by Butlin's in the form of a *COVID Protection Guarantee* so attendees can receive a full refund for any COVID-related reason they cannot attend up to three days before the event starts.
