A CLERGY INTRODUCTORY PILGRIMAGE

16-23 January 2023

This is an invitation to visit the Holy Land and see first hand the work of McCabe Pilgrimages and the McCabe Educational Trust. It is absolutely the best preparation and introduction to the idea of parish pilgrimage. We don't mind if you are actively planning a parish trip or if you would just like to come along for the experience; either way, you will be made very welcome. Central to the McCabe vision is a commitment to introducing church leaders to the Land of the Bible. We believe as a result that your ministry will be enhanced beyond measure.

We conduct these tours as an actual pilgrimage with prayers and readings at the sites and we feature visits to at least two projects supported by The McCabe Educational Trust. Please do consider joining us.

The pilgrimage cost of £745 is refundable if you organise and lead a parish pilgrimage to the Holy Land with us.

Eligibility is restricted to clergy and those training for the ministry and their spouses.

TOUR INFORMATION

The cost is a heavily subsidised at £745 per person sharing a twin-bedded room with en suite bathroom and is fully refundable if you decide in the future to take your church on pilgrimage.

Spouses are welcome at a cost of £895.

We stay in our two recommended pilgrimage hotels: in Jerusalem Fahmi Nashashibi hosts us for a four night stay at the Golden Walls Hotel overlooking the walls of the Old City and close to all the biblical sites we'll be visiting. In Tiberias we are the guests of the Amsalem brothers at the Ron Beach Hotel right by the Sea of Galilee.

We have made this experience comprehensive and inclusive. All visits with entrance fees are included as are tips to driver, guide, hotels, etc, and all meals.

Nazareth Coach Company provides airconditioned coaches and leadership will be shared between an experienced pilgrimage leader from the UK and one of our team of local Christian guides. Flights are with easyJet direct from Manchester to Tel Aviv. **Visas** are not required for British passport holders. Please contact us if you are a non-British passport holder as you may need to apply for a visa in advance.

Not included: Travel insurance—this is essential for all travellers. As soon as we have a policy arranged for 2023 we will advise the premiums. Once you have paid your deposit, should you need to cancel for medical/other reasons generally covered by insurance, until 31 March 2022 we will refund your deposit in full. We require all travelers

to have adequate cover for the trip and you may travel under any suitable travel insurance policy.

Single rooms - we've managed to reduce the cost of the single supplement for this special introductory pilgrimage. The supplement for a single room is £250.

Any special requests should be noted on the booking form.

A deposit is payable at the time of booking and the balance is then payable eight weeks prior to departure.

DAILY PROGRAMME





Monday 16 January | JERUSALEM

We meet at Manchester Airport. easyJet flight EZY 1827 departs at 12:25, arriving at 19:40. Transfer to our hotel in Jerusalem. Four night stay at the Golden Walls Hotel close to the Old City and the biblical sites we shall visit.

Tuesday | MT OF OLIVES & MT ZION

We drive to the Mount of Olives where we have a panoramic view of the walled city. Visit Dominus Flevit Chapel, the Church of All Nations in the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of St Peter in Gallicantu, traditionally, the site of the High Priest's house.

Lunch and Eucharist at St Andrew's Guest House. We drive to the village of Ein Karem, birthplace of John the Baptist and visit the church there. Continue to the Israel Museum to visit the model of Ancient Jerusalem and see some of the Dead Sea Scrolls.

Wednesday | THE VIA DOLOROSA

We enter the walled city and begin our morning by the Pool of Bethesda and Church of St Anne. We then follow the Via Dolorosa through the lanes of the Old City to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre.

Lunch at Bulghourji restaurant in the Armenian Quarter and drive to Bethany. Visit the church and tomb of Lazarus as well as Jeel al-Amal boys' home supported by the McCabe Educational Trust. We end our afternoon at the Western Wall, the holiest site for Jews, as the Sabbath begins.

Thursday | BETHLEHEM

We begin at the Garden Tomb and then drive to Bethlehem and the Shepherds' Fields (Eucharist). Time for some olivewood shopping at a local cooperative.

Lunch at the Bethlehem Rehabilitation Centre where we meet the staff and hear about their work. We then visit Manger Square, the Basilica and Grotto of the Nativity and St Jerome's Caves.

Friday | JERICHO & THEJORDAN VALLEY

We leave Jerusalem for the Galilee. We drive first to the village of Bethany (home of Martha, Mary and Lazarus) where we visit the church and the tomb of Lazarus. We also call at the Jeel al-Amal boys home which is supported by the MaCabe Educational Trust. We continue to Jericho stopping en route at the Wadi Qelt to view St George's desert monastery.

Lunch in Jericho at the al-Rawdah Restaurant and view the Mount of Temptation. Continue north through the Jordan Valley to Tiberias stopping en route at the Jordan River baptismal site. Three night stay at the Ron Beach Hotel by the Sea of Galilee with visits to places associated with Jesus' early life and ministry.

Saturday | THE LAKESIDE MINISTRY

Today we visit the sites associated with Jesus' life around the Sea of Galilee. We drive to the north of the lake and visit the ruins of Capernaum, Jesus' Galilean base. After visiting Mensa Christi, where

Jesus appeared to his disciples after His resurrection, and Tabgha (Eucharist). We visit the Convent of Beatitudes' church and garden commemorating the Sermon on the Mount.

Lunch here in the guest house and sail across the Sea of Galilee back to our hotel, returning by mid-afternoon with time to relax and swim.

Sunday | MT TABOR & NAZARETH

We drive to Nazareth via Cana, scene of Jesus' first miracle. Continue to St Gabriel's Orthodox church where we visit Mary's Well and then walk through the Souk to Christ Church, the Anglican church in Nazareth and join their congregation. We have lunch at the Holy Land Restaurant. After visiting the Basilica of the Annunciation we drive to Mount Tabor, navigating its winding road to reach the Basilica of the Transfiguration with its views over the Plain of Armageddon.

Monday 23 January | CAESAREA

We leave Tiberias and drive to the Mediterranean coast and the Roman capital of Caesarea Maratima, where we visit the restored amphitheatre and aqueduct.

Lunch at the Port Café restaurant and spend some time in Jaffa before we drive to Ben Gurion Airport. easyJet flight EZY 1828 departs at 20:35 arriving into Manchester Airport at 00:25 (+1).

OUR PILGRIMAGE

The McCabe Educational Trust

For many, meeting the 'Living Stones' of The Land becomes a real highlight of their pilgrimage. The McCabe Educational Trust is an independent registered charity with the aim of helping inspiring people we meet on pilgrimage. On your pilgrimage you will meet some of these people. As 'the haves' encounter the 'have nots' the Trust has become a practical tool for one to help the other.

McCabe Pilgrimages invite all travellers to become partners in this work. A £15 voluntary donation to the Trust's work is added to every pilgrim's invoice and all money raised in this way is given in full to the projects the Trust supports. This scheme is voluntary and confidential with nobody put under any pressure to participate.



TRAVELLING ALONE

Many of our passengers travel alone and object to expensive single room supplements. McCabe Pilgrimages will accept individual bookings on a 'guaranteed share' basis. We charge the basic price and accommodate you with a person of the same sex also requesting shared accommodation. If we do not find someone to share with you, you will be accommodated in a single room at only 50% of the usual single room supplement. For single travellers who do require single accommodation this should be requested when booking and, if available, the normal supplement will be payable.

PASSPORTS, VISAS AND HEALTH

Please ensure that your passport is valid for at least six months after the time of this pilgrimage. If you need a new passport apply early as there can be considerable backlogs at the passport offices. A visa is issued free of charge on entering Israel and there are currently no further requirements for entering the Palestinian territories. If you are holding a non-British passport, or require further advice, please consult the McCabe office. No inoculations are required but we advise you to consult your doctor regarding your own personal requirements.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Our policy includes COVID-19 cover. A special feature of the policy recommended by McCabe is that you do not need to declare medical conditions or call a medical screening service. Most pre-existing health conditions are covered as long as your doctor agrees that you are fit to travel.

We have arranged a holiday insurance policy underwritten by AWP P&C SA and administered in the UK by Allianz Global Assistance which is a trading name of AWP Assistance UK Limited, AWP Assistance UK Limited is authorised and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority. AWP P&C SA is duly authorised in France and the United Kingdom and subject to limited regulation by the Prudential Regulation Authority and the Financial Conduct Authority. McCabe Travel Ltd is an Appointed Representative of Global Travel Insurance Services Ltd who is authorised and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority (firm reference 305686) being permitted to advise and arrange general insurance contracts. Our status can be checked on the Financial Conduct Authority Register by visiting www.fca.org.uk or calling 0845 606 9966.

The policy has been specifically designed so that it covers all McCabe holidays; protecting you in full if you have to cancel and providing you with the very best and most effective protection if you are unfortunate enough to require medical attention whilst away. Standard exclusions apply and are listed on the summary document which is available on request. Please check that you are not affected by the Main Health Exclusions. You will not be covered for any ongoing tests or treatment of an undiagnosed condition, or for any terminal illness, or if you claim as a result of a condition arising within the past twelve months. If you have a medical condition, you must obtain verbal confirmation from your medical practitioner that there is no reason why you should not travel and you must ensure that this confirmation is recorded in your notes.

Note that you will be required to pay an excess of £1,000 on any claim that results directly from a pre-existing medical condition.

A full policy wording will be sent to you with confirmation of your booking, or ask us and we will send you a summary now. Full details are also on our website. This insurance is only available to persons who are permanently resident in the UK.
