Clerical Errors – United and Re-formed!

Clerical Errors was formed by the Revds Anton Müller and Steve Carter with retired priest Chris Morris, formerly vicar of Lanercost Priory. At the time Steve was the vicar of Dalston with Cumdivock, Raughton Head and Wreay. They gave many concerts in support of local churches and charities until Anton moved to Lancashire to be the vicar of the United Parish of Scorton, Barnacre and Calder Vale. The name "Clerical Errors" is inspired by the book of that title by Diane Greenwood who was the Diocesan Director of Education in Rochester when Anton worked at Rochester Cathedral.

The Revd Anton Müller (Flute) Anglican

After graduating in Theology from Durham University he trained as a teacher in RE, Music and Drama. Anton first met Kevin Huggett in Durham where, as students, they played in the Christian Rock Band "Last Resort"! Anton is the County Ecumenical Officer for Churches Together in Lancashire and recognises the ecumenical gift that music brings.

The Revd Steve Carter (Guitar) Anglican

Steve served as Vicar of Dalston with Cumdivock, Raughton Head and Wreay (just south of Carlisle) for 15 years until his retirement in 2019, having previously served for the previous 15 years as a SAMS mission partner in Peru and Uruguay. He now helps his wife, Pauline Steenbergen, to lead a pioneer ministry for the Diocese of Carlisle called 'Maranatha Yoga', as well as enjoying playing both the guitar and golf!

The Revd Kevin Huggett (Bass) URC/CofE

Kevin is a retired Anglican Priest and is currently working for three years as an outreach worker for Kendal United Reformed Church. Kevin loves making music and is currently working on a 'sacred jazz' project with some other local musicians, reimagining a wide variety of church worship music in jazz style. Kevin is excited to be reunited with Anton and Steve who he has known and made music alongside since he was a teenager!

The Revds Andrew and Kath Dodd (Guitar and Vocal, Piano) Baptist

Andrew and Kath Dodd have recently retired from working together for nearly 30 years as joint ministers at Hawkshead Hill Baptist Chapel. Music has been a huge and enriching part of Kath's life. Kath holds an ATCL (piano performance diploma) and has taught piano and class music; accompanied school productions, soloists, church worship; and experimented with music and meditation. She is keen to take every opportunity to make music – and hopefully make others happy as a result!

Andrew took up the guitar in his early 20s, formed a band to lead in worship and took the local church into new territory in its worship. The band recorded three albums and contributed to the use and development of contemporary worship music. Having enjoyed occasional rock and blues gigs over the years with school friends he is going back to his folk roots.

William Nixon (Piano and Flute)

William attended Caldew School in Dalston where Anton was teaching music and drama. From Year 7 William showed a real aptitude and love of music. He had piano and flute lessons with Anton. When Anton moved to take up a parish in Lancashire William was taken on by Michael Hancock under whose skilful guidance William secured a place at the Birmingham Conservatoire. William is also a gifted tailor and after graduating from the Birmingham Conservatoire was taken on by the renowned bespoke Tailors Redmayne in Wigton (as seen on TV!). William continues to enjoy music and taking part in concerts and recitals around the county of Cumbria.

Roseanna Sharples (Vocals)
