## **About the**Conference

Blackburn Cathedral is hosting a Creation Care Conference from 31st October to 1st November, bringing together voices from across the Christian spectrum to explore how faith communities can respond to the environmental crisis.

The event takes place in the awe-inspiring presence of Gaia, a large-scale sculpture of the Earth by internationally-renowned artist Luke Jerram. Suspended in the Cathedral's nave, this striking installation prompts a fundamental question: "What is the relationship between Christianity and concern for human-made climate change?"

Dr Canon Ruth Valerio, a theologian, environmentalist, and social activist, will headline the conference.

As Programmes, Partnerships & Advocacy Director at Embrace the Middle East, Canon Theologian at Rochester Cathedral and author of 'Saying Yes to Life', Valerio brings deep theological insight and practical experience to questions of environmental justice.

She is known for helping churches engage with creation care as an integral part of Christian discipleship, drawing from Scripture, theology, and lived practice.

Her work combines academic insight with practical experience in community-based environmental action, making her uniquely equipped to address the conference's themes.
