Thursday Lent talks

Each Thursday at 7pm (25th Feb-25th March) will be a brief talk from one of the clergy on the theme of 'God's story, our story' followed by a chance for questions and conversation. The whole session will last no more than 30 minutes. We will use Zoom, and upload the 'talk' part to YouTube afterwards. Please email missioner@blackburncathedral.co.uk for the Zoom link.

Study groups

Each week following the talk, the same theme will be picked up in our Lent groups. We are offering four groups this year, all by Zoom. Each session will last no more than 45 minutes. If you would like to join one of the groups, please contact missioner@blackburncathedral.co.uk indicating which of the following you could manage:

- Monday evenings
- Tuesday evenings
- Friday lunchtimes
- Saturday mornings

Please indicate <u>all</u> of the times you could manage, so that you can be allocated to a group and we can manage numbers. NB if you can attend both a study group and the Thursday talks, that is great, but each stands alone!
