NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

#### ALTHAM, St. JAMES

DESCRIPTION OF WORK RELATING TO THE REMOVAL OF THE FRONT PEWS – IN CENTRE AND NORTH AND SOUTH AISLES

The church has identified a need to increase the space available at the front of the Nave as the Pews encroach closely on the Pulpit. In order to create more space, it is proposed to remove the front box pew, thereby taking the frontage of the box pews back by approximately 900mm.

This additional space will be beneficial for worship and circulation and will be of particular benefit during the proposed work to the chancel roof, as the chancel will be closed off during the construction. As the box pews are uniform in size and construction it is proposed to remove the front pew bench and

attached doors, then relocate the front enclosure and attached doors to be in place of the existing bench. The removed pew to be kept intact and stored in the church.

The timber plinth upstand is to be reduced back to the new box pew frontage to replicate the existing form. A new poured in-situ concrete slab is to be poured and new reclaimed flags sourced and laid over to match the finish of the existing floor.

The radiant heating pipes will be shortened to wrap around the base of the pews in their altered position. To improve access to the new interactive screen, it is proposed that the enclosed box pew at the east end of the North Aisle is to be modified by removing the decorative pew end, infill panel and door. The section of bench seating to be removed and all remaining joinery finishes to be carefully restored.
