Your Church, Your Gift

The policy of the PCC is to use gifts in wills to help fund significant development projects in the parish. Since needs change over the years, we encourage church members to leave a gift in your will for the general purposes of the parish, rather than for a specified purpose.

A generous legacy of £5,000 enabled one Church in Leyland Deanery to replace broken windows in their church hall. The hall now provides a welcoming space for both Church and local groups.
