



Blackburn Prayers November 2020

Since March we have seen unprecedented events taking place in our country and around the world in response to the coronavirus outbreak.

A regular update for parishes continues to be sent from Bishop Philip and the Coronavirus Task Group; those updates are also available on the main <u>coronavirus advice page</u> where you will also find other useful information and links onwards to further guidance. In one of the earliest task group updates after lockdown Bishop Philip wrote that, above all, we must give ourselves at this time to the work of prayer. As the pandemic persists, so our prayer also continues to be vital of course. That is why we are continuing to open with a special intention each day in Blackburn Prayers to help us to pray into the current crisis.

Meanwhile, this month we have all been invited by Bishop Julian to participate in a 'Call to Pray and Give' from November 12-29. This is a Diocesan-led initiative to boost parish funds at the end of this very challenging year, to enable current levels of stipendiary mission and ministry to continue.

The hope is that at the culmination of 17 days of prayer (including times of fasting) on Advent Sunday - November 29 - each parish in the Diocese will allow an opportunity for gifts to be presented. That's why, as part of our preparation for and participation in the 'Call to Pray and Give', we have also included some specific additional prayer points for this month only.
