



# **Blackburn Prayers March 2022**

As we were preparing Blackburn Prayers for this month, we heard the terrible news about the invasion of Ukraine. Bishop Julian and his entire Leadership Team sent a message to parishes condemning the Russian Federation's actions and inviting the whole Diocese to pray in the coming days, as requested of all Dioceses by our Archbishops.
