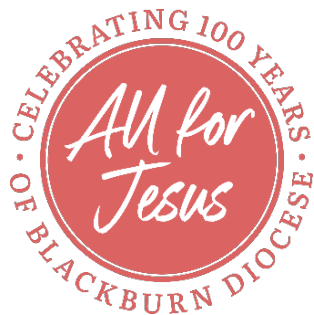




Blackburn Prayers February 2026

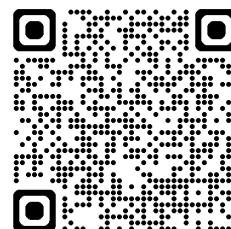
