As part of the 'Children Changing Places' project we are looking to appoint two Deanery Children and Family Workers to work alongside parish teams and CE primary schools, in an identified cohort of 10 schools, in order to develop Christian discipleship pathways for primary school age children and their families.

The post-holders will have a minimum of three years' experience of working with children and/or families. They will be creative and able to lead and support activities in schools. They will be excellent communicators with good interpersonal skills and listening ears. They will be able to build and maintain working partnerships and have a working understanding of child safeguarding principles and practice.

There is an occupational requirement for the post-holders to be practising Christians, in accordance with Schedule 9 to the Equality Act 2010.
